EQUIPMENT

WHAT DO WE DO?

The people who answer the call for help are extraordinary people who volunteer their time every day.

These individuals are people just like *you!*

These people answer motor vehicle accidents, structure fires, emergency medical needs, and many other hazards that occur daily. In addition to answering calls, many of these personnel assist with fundraising, assist in keeping the station and apparatus clean, and maintain many daily administrative needs that are required through the local, state and federal governments.

APPARATUS

The Company currently owns and operates the following emergency equipment and apparatus:

FIRE:

Rescue Engine 12, Engine 12, Tanker 12, Attack 12, and Chief 12 (command vehicle)

EMS:

Ambulance 12-1, Ambulance 12-2, ALS 12 (Advanced Life Support), and Mobile 12

Both the ALS and the Mobile vehicles were purchased by the Company's Auxiliary and donated to the Company.

The cost of protecting a fire fighter is immense. The cost averages around \$7,000 per fire fighter for protective clothing and gear, self-contained breathing apparatus, helmets, and pagers. That's not to mention all of the other equipment that is needed to respond to an incident.
